It got the status of first Central Prison in the year 1864. Later in 1906 this jail shifted to the bank of Adi Ganga. Recently, the government closed the jail and made it a historical museum.

The students visited the campus with great enthusiasm and saw the Prisoners' Cell of our National Heroes. Notable freedom fighter who were incarcerated here include Jawaharlal Nehru, Subhas Chandra Bose, Chittaranjan Das, Dinesh Gupta, Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy to name a few.
