POSTMENOPAUSAL OSTEOPOROSIS

- Osteoporosis is a bone disease associated with loss of bone mineral density and increased incidence of hip and vertebral fractures.
- In postmenopausal females, the estrogen deficiency causes an increase in the RANKL, which causes increase in the osteoclastic activity and hence, shifts the bone remodeling towards a bone resorbing balance which leads to osteoporosis.
- Bone loss is maximum 3-5 years before menopause and also 3-5 years after menopause.



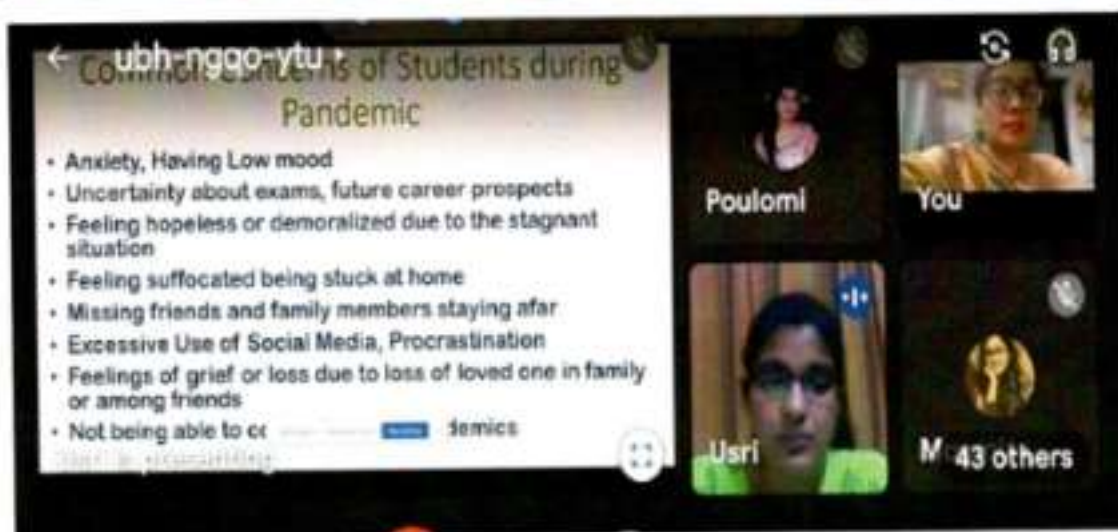

**Sl. No. 19: GMGC COVID HELP LINE:**

The NSS Unit-I of Gokhale Memorial Girl's College took the initiative of helping people out by using social media as a medium. A group named GMGC HELPLINE was created in Whatsapp on 5th May 2021 and currently that group contains NSS and non NSS students from various departments, ex-Gokhalites, teaching and non teaching staff, summing up to around 100 active members.

A poster has been circulated in every possible medium with contact numbers of the front desk members of GMGC HELPLINE, which operates all over West Bengal. This Helpline started with the initiative of NSS unit but it has been operational with the effort of the entire college.

**THE WAY IT WORKS:**

Since May 5, 2021 to till July 22, 2021, GMGC Helpline has stayed open 24/7. More than 200 cases have been solved by the Helpline team till today.

This helpline has been organized and divided into front desk members and back end verifiers. The front desk members contact the patient family directly before handling any case and the back end verifiers continuously verify contacts before providing any lead to the patient family.

The main group has segregation and for each segregation, different Whatsapp groups have been created. The four groups are:

1. Hospital Group
2. Oxygen Group
3. Blood and Plasma Group
4. Food Group

Now, each group has 2 front desk members assigned to them, 2 of them are further divided into morning shift and night shift( 12am-12pm and vice versa) and they get calls accordingly. But the front desk members are there in all the groups so that they can work in place of someone who is currently inactive.

Each of these groups also contain a set of back end verifiers which is different for each group. The back end verifiers keep verifying these contacts as and when any patient family reach us out. So, by doing this, giving a list of numbers, from which half of them doesn't work to a distressed family, can be avoided.

**PROTOCOLS:**

Any sort of leads is not provided without patient verification so that there is no misuse of information. Front desk members try to communicate with the patient family as much as possible and try to be there for them and be empathetic in our approach.

Everything that is done, strictly falls under government circular and anything that is beyond, is prohibited in this helpline. The sole motive is to help people out in this dire situation by creating a network. The organization and maintenance of information are the key priorities of GMGC HELPLINE.

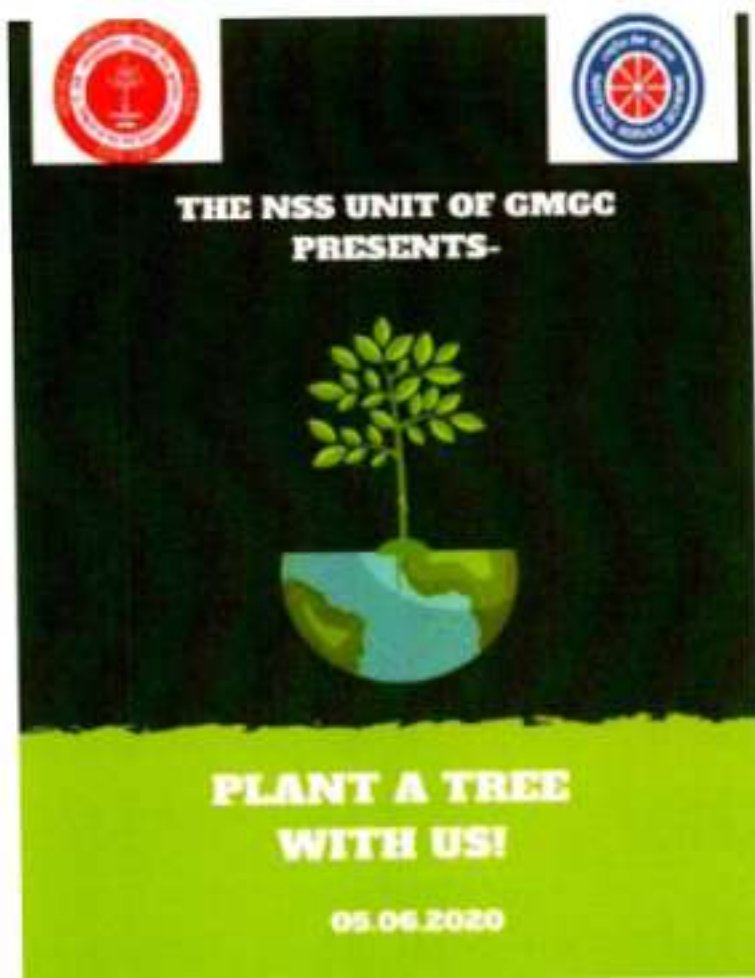

According to Dr. Chatterjee the important points to avoid the stress are:

3. To stay away from intoxicants like alcohol, cigarettes or any recreational drugs.
4. To get news updates from trusted sources to avoid fake news.
5. To stay away from news which makes one upset, ie, stay aware but don't panic.
6. To adopt activities which are both entertaining and increases skills.

One must always be in the present rather than expressing despair for the past or daydream about future, because if done so then he/she misses on what is there in front of him/her. Today makes tomorrow so if we focus on today then it will give positive results in the future, on the other hand what has happened cannot be changed then thinking about it lessens visibility of the now. So the optimum option is to be in the 'now'. Although controlling the mind is quite difficult but can be done by self analysis, and this is called mindfulness. This path can lead to potential bliss during the times of stress like these.
