## **Objectives of the Course**

- 1. To train students to listen and understand familiar phrases and sentences concerning themselves, their family and immediate surroundings.
- 2. To teach students to be able to pick out some of the details from short spoken passages which are clearly articulated and also understand and follow classroom instructions in German.
- 3. Teaching students to introduce themselves and others, to be able to communicate by asking and answering questions about themselves, their family and surroundings.
- 4. To train students to recognise and understand some familiar words and phrases in written form, follow short texts on a known topic and understand some of the main points from it. Also, they should be able to write words, phrases and a few sentences using a model and write simple phrases and sentences about themselves, their family and friends, where they live and what they do. Basic Communication skills for real life situations will be taught.
