The outcome of the Competition(within 100 words): On the 29th of May, 3 students accompanied by professor Shubham Dutta of Gokhale Memorial Girls College participated in a debate competition organised by the Mandias Debate Club of Jodhpur Search in collaboration with Netaji Nagar College (Evening).
