

Samapti Chatterjee



The Hon'ble Justice Samapti Chatterjee (B.A., LL.B.) born in the year 1958 on 13 December. She is former judge of the Calcutta High Court in West Bengal, India. She gained public attention after quashing a non-confidence motion passed against the mayor of Bidhannagar, West Bengal, in a widely reported hearing. Samapti Chatterjee earned a Bachelor of Arts from **Gokhale Memorial Girls' College** and a law degree from Calcutta University. She also appeared before the Supreme Court of India, the High Court at Patna and the West Bengal State Administrative Tribunal very frequently. Practised in Civil, Criminal, Constitutional, Company, Labour, Arbitration and Service laws, but specialised in Service Law and Constitutional matters.

Samapti Chatterjee enrolled with the **Bar Council of West Bengal** in 1985 and practiced law at the **Calcutta High Court**, as well as other courts and tribunals. She was appointed as an **additional judge** of the **Calcutta High Court** on 30 October 2013. She was appointed as **Permanent Judge of the Calcutta High Court** on 14.03.2016. She retired on 12 December 2020.
