Policy Document Student Welfare Sub-Committee

The Institution of Gokhale Memorial Girls' College is committed to the social welfare of students hailing from different social classes. It strives to bring about social equity by providing financial assistance to students belonging to economically backward and under-privileged sections of the society. The aim of such financial assistance and scholarship is to eradicate the social, cultural and economic barriers that the students from these sections grapple with on a regular basis.

The Students' Welfare Sub-Committee of Gokhale Memorial Girls' College, offers fellowships or partial financial assistance to needy students of the institution every year. Every year, the committee invites applications from such students and disburses a minimum amount from the money received from the Shivani Chatterjee Memorial Fund and the Students' Welfare Fund.

The eligibility criteria for students to receive financial assistance, are altered from time to time as reflected in changes in the family income of the incumbent. Such changes are notified to the students through the college notice board.
