- 5. Promote values of equality, secularism and national integration.
- 6. Build a collaborative working environment in which respectful interaction with the peers can take place.
- 7. Uphold gender equity.
- 8. Maintain campus cleanliness and hygiene.
- 9. Should come to the college formally and decently dressed.
- 10.Be committed to environmental sustainability and not indulge in wasteful practices.
- 11.Always treat College property, furniture, library books, laboratory equipment etc. with due care.
- 12.Shall ensure anti-ragging in strict adherence to the parameters of the Lyngdoh Committee set up by the MHRD in 2006 to frame guidelines for Code of Conduct specifically for holding student elections but generally for on campus behaviour read as "No candidate will indulge in, nor abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic groups or groups of students. Criticism of other candidates will be confined to their policies and programmes, past record and work. Contestants will refrain from criticism of all aspects of private life not of other candidates. There will be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for votes and places of worship will not be used for electoral propaganda. Candidates will be prohibited from indulging in or abetting "corrupt practices" and offences like bribing, intimidation or impersonation. The candidates will be prohibited from canvassing within 100 meters of polling stations, holding public meetings 24 hours before the end poll and the transport and conveyance of voters to and from polling stations. No printed posters, pamphlets will be allowed and only handmade material will be permitted at places notified by the authorities. No defacement or destruction of property of the college/university will be permitted." Indulging in or abetment of ragging is a punishable offence. The College has an Anti-ragging Committee to deal with such undesirable activities.
