In the Memo No. 1015 dated 28.6.2017 of DTA (Annexure I) it has already been informed that no deduction of STDS or TCS under the WBVAT Act, 2003 shall be made w.e.f. 01.07 2017. Further, the similar provision for deduction of TDS under the GST Law has not yet oeen made operational and so no deduction on account of CGST/SGST/IGST shall be made by DDOs of West Bengal Government and Local Authorities, Statutory bodies, autonomous institutions, PSUs, etc. under the administrative control of Government of West Bengal until further communication.

In the meantime all the DDOs of West Bengal Government and Local Authorities, Statutory bodies, autonomous institutions, PSUs, etc under the administrative control of Government of West Bengal, are hereby directed to get themselves registered and obtain a GSTIN [Goods & Services Tax Identification Number] as a tax deductor through electronic process in the portal <u>www.gst.gov.in</u> by using their PAN/TAN.
